These individuals will be placed in **paid** Temporary Jobs to repair public property affected by the natural disaster.

- Paid Formal Training
- Paid on the Job Training
- Supportive Services

These federally funded services can be yours if you are eligible for the NDWG grants! If you answer yes to any of the following questions, you could be eligible to participate:

- 1) Are you temporarily or permanently laid off as a consequence of the natural disaster?
- 2) Were you self-employed and became unemployed as a result of the Woolsey/Hill Fire?
- 3) Have you been long-term unemployed, for 6 months or more?
