### Santa Barbara County Youth Careers

### SERVICE AREA: SANTA BARBARA COUNTY



Operating offices in Santa Maria, Lompoc, and Santa Barbara

Allows program participants **ages 14-24** to gain access to work readiness workshops, paid work experience, community resources, post- secondary education enrollment, vocational training, supported services, and incentives for program completion.

#### **Benefits of enrolling:**

- Career Navigation
- Up to 170 of paid work experience
- Assistance with items such as; books, transportation, uniforms

#### How to qualify:

- Must be between the ages of 14-24
- A barrier to employment or education



# STEPS-Summer Training and Employment for Students

### SERVICE AREA: SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

The Summer Training and Employment Program for Students or STEPS is a program designed to provide participants with 40 hours of Job Readiness Training to include Resume writing, Interview Skills and Customer Service trainings to prepare them for Work Experience. This program offers 185 hours of Paid Work Experience for youth.

#### **Eligibility:**

Must be in school and between the ages of 16-21 Must have an IEP, 504 plan or if in College a Documented disability





## Department of Rehabilitation Student Services

### SERVICE AREA: SANTA BARBARA COUNTY



Students in school ages 16-21 are eligible to participate in this program. Participants work with an Employment Service Coordinator and receive basic employment preparation such as interview practice and resume writing. Participants then get placed into a paid Work Experience for up to 90 days or 100 hours.





## Department of Rehabilitation Adult Services

### SERVICE AREA: SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

GoodwillVSB is a vendor of the Department of Rehabilitation (DOR) and provide employment services to individuals with disabilities. Our program is referral based, and all referrals must be received from DOR. We focus on providing direct placement into competitive employment with employers in the community. We do not currently provide supported employment services.





### Prison to Employment (P2E) Santa Barbara County

#### SERVICE AREA: SANTA BARBARA COUNTY



Justice Involved participants are referred to our offices and are eligible to receive Paid Work Experience, supportive services, and formal training. Individuals work with an Employment Service Coordinator to create an individualized employment plan that meets their needs, and that provides them the opportunity to re-enter the workforce once they have completed their Paid Work Experience or formal training.



# Probation

### SERVICE AREA: SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

This program is referral based and provides employment preparation for persons who are justice involved. Participants will work with an Employment Services Coordinator on items such as creating a master application, building a resume, practicing interview skills and applying online for open positions. This program also offers up to 30 days of subsidized employment upon a conditional job offer.





### Veteran Employment-Related Assistance Program (VEAP)

### SERVICE AREA: SANTA BARBARA COUNTY



Participants work with an Employment Service Coordinator, who helps guide program participants through the program and provide employment resources and assistance. We understand the unique challenges veterans and their family members might face when it comes to finding meaningful employment. This program provides Paid Work Experience for Veterans and their Spouses as well as Supportive Services to be successful in the program as well as in their permanent job placement once Work Experience is complete.

#### **Eligibility:**

Be a veteran or active-duty spouse to be eligible. DD214 or Proof of Service Letter.
